RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 20-056**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR PROJECT NO. 10183, FUND 405 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, FURNITURE, FIXTURES, AND EQUIPMENT FOR A NEW STATION 6-2; UPGRADES TO THE OLD STATION 6-2; AND BUILD OUT OF THE CENTRAL MAT-SU FIRE SERVICE AREA TRAINING COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2016-016, \$3,300,000 was appropriated to project 10183-6601 for the construction, furniture, fixtures, and equipment for a new Station 6-2; and

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2017-008, an additional \$4,874,486.64 was added to this project to complete the build and purchase of needed items for the new Station 6-2; and

WHEREAS, the construction and purchase of furniture, fixtures, and equipment for the new Station 6-2 is now complete and there is a remaining balance in the project in the amount of \$739,004.30; and

WHEREAS, the old Station 6-2 is currently being utilized as the logistics warehouse and will need renovations, upgrades, and the addition of a fire suppression sprinkler system to make the building safe and functional; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area is developing additional training features for their training complex such as a vehicle extraction area, driving operator skills area, technical rescue area, hazmat training area and a live fire prop exercise area; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Chief is requesting a revision in the scope of work to include upgrades to the old Station 6-2 and a build out of the training complex.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following amended scope of work for Project No. 10183.

SCOPE OF WORK

Construction of a new Station 6-2 to include furniture, fixtures, and equipment; upgrades to the old Station 6-2 to include all building systems, design, permitting, testing and construction; and buildout of the Training Complex to include all building systems, design, permitting, testing and construction.
