A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY PROPOSED CAPPED IMPROVED PROJECT VALUE OF \$36,289,845 FOR THE HOUSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the November 30, 2018, earthquake significantly damaged Houston Middle School resulting in the condemnation and demolition of the facility; and

WHEREAS, an insurance settlement of \$19,600,000 has been received; and

WHEREAS, in May 2021, the Federal Emergency Management Agency proposed a capped improved project value of \$36,289,845, that will be netted against the insurance settlement; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2021, the Assembly awarded a contract for the Construction of Houston Middle school to Roger Hickel Contracting, Inc, in the amount of \$33,270,169; and

WHEREAS, the contract awarded is under the Federal Emergency Management Agency's proposed capped improved project value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly does hereby accept the capped improved project value of \$36,289,845 for the Houston Middle School, and requests the Federal Emergency Management Agency prepare the necessary agreements.
