A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET OF \$40,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE FOR THE COLLECTION OF AERIAL IMAGERY AND LIDAR ELEVATION DATA.

WHEREAS, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) has offered, through a cooperative agreement, \$40,000 to support the efforts of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Aerial Imagery and Elevation Data Program; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was selected for this award by the Mat-Su Basin Salmon Habitat Partnership, which is part of the National Fish Habitat Partnership; and

WHEREAS, imagery and elevation data are critical tools for making well-informed decisions, reducing fieldwork, and supporting government services as well as commercial and private endeavors; and

WHEREAS, this award requires a \$40,000 match, which will come from project no. 47519, fund 480.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly does hereby approve the following scope of work and budget.

### SCOPE OF WORK

The collection of Aerial Imagery and Elevation data for the Matanuska-Susitna Borough; requires a 50 percent match.
