**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-095**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING A REALLOCATION OF \$49,000 FROM THE COMPLETED TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE RECREATION FACILITY HIGHWAY SIGNAGE PROJECT, FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 15035; TO THE WILLOW AND TALKEETNA OUTDOOR ICE RINKS OPEN AIR ROOF SYSTEM DESIGN BUILD PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 15044, FUND 440.

WHEREAS, in 2016, Ordinance Serial No. 16-085 was approved by the Assembly authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds and for providing for the submission to the voters of the Borough of a proposition ratifying the authorization of such bonds at the October 3, 2016, Borough regular election; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2016, voters ratified the authorization of such bonds; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for the Willow and Talkeetna Outdoor Ice Rinks Open Air Roof System Design Build Project was developed through public meetings and user group input; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen site conditions at Talkeetna, dasher boards had to be demolished in order to excavate inferior materials and new dasher boards were not awarded in the construction contract due to tight budget; and

WHEREAS, the public has requested the original scope to be funded to finish the project; and

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate \$49,000 from project no. 15035.1852, fund 480, to project no. 15044, fund 440, to allow for revised scope of work to the Willow and Talkeetna Open Air Roof System Design Build Project.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.


