SUMMARY STATEMENT: On April 17, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly approved AM 18-026 awarding contract 18-096B to Orion Construction, for the Wasilla Pool Improvements in the amount of \$5,494,000.00.

Contract award AM 18-026 did not include staff change order authority. This project involves extensive renovations in an old building with a high probability of unforeseen conditions typical of work associated with renovation projects.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: On February 16, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to provide labor, equipment and materials to remove and replace the entire pool basin with a six lane competition pool, diving well and separate area dedicated to swimming lessons.
