SUMMARY STATEMENT: This legislation will amend the scopes of work on two projects, the Website Upgrade project, and the GIS Online Mapping project.

Funding was allocated in the fiscal year 2024 Capital Budget to complete upgrades on the Borough Website. In the fiscal year 2021 and 2022 Capital Budget, funding was allocated for the GIS Online Mapping project.

The scopes of work for each project currently do not allow for the choice of hiring a consultant or using a project employee to complete aspects of the project. The proposed amendments will allow

for the choice of the most efficient and cost-effective method to complete the projects, while not limiting the use to either method. This change will not affect the expiration date of either project, and will allow the borough to successfully complete the scopes as originally intended.
