**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** On April 15, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to provide labor, equipment and materials to remove and replace an existing culvert for Meadow Creek under Lucille Street just north of the Seldon-Lucille intersection. The project will replace the existing 100-foot long 48-Inch diameter culvert with a 72-Inch diameter corrugated steel pipe (CSP). Construction includes removal of the existing pavement, excavation and removal of the existing pipe, installation of the 72-Inch CSP and replacement of the road embankment. Construction Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly district #6.

In response to the advertisement, five bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Dirtworks, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

The substantial completion date for this project is August 31, 2022 with the final completion of October 31, 2022.

In accordance with MSB 3.08.170(B), Administration requests authority to modify the resulting contract completion date by 30 days for unforeseen circumstances.

The Public Works Department, Operations & Maintenance will be administering the contract with the aid of The Boutet Company, Inc. who will be performing construction administration services.

**BID 22-137B**

**SCOPE OF WORK**

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough is soliciting bids from qualified contractors to provide labor, equipment and materials to remove and replace an existing culvert for Meadow Creek under Lucille Street just north of the Seldon-Lucille intersection. The project will replace the existing 100-foot long 48-Inch diameter culvert with a 72-Inch diameter corrugated steel pipe (CSP). Construction includes removal of the existing pavement, excavation and removal of the existing pipe, installation of the 72-Inch CSP and replacement of the road embankment.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

Supply labor, supervision, equipment, materials and supplies to perform the required work as shown on construction documents for Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) project number 47514.

Contractor must develop a Hazardous Material Control Plan (HMCP) and Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan.

Contractor shall coordinate the road improvements with all utility relocation work. Request locates from the utilities having facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Dig-line, Inc. Locate Call Center. See Section 105-1.06 for dig-line number and a list of utility companies in the area.

Complete work between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Traffic shall not be restricted during holiday weekends for Memorial Day and Fourth of July Holidays as discussed in section 643 of the Project Special Provisions. Contractor shall make all efforts to not restrict school traffic during student arrival and departure times, ending May 20, 2022.

Time is of the essence. Work shall be completed in one continuous timeframe, after utility relocations are completed. Please see SECTION V - SAMPLE AGREEMENT, Section 3. Agreement Time for substantial and final completion dates.

Estimated project magnitude is less than \$145,000.
