RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 20-102**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR ADDITIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FROM THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE DISASTER BOROUGH WIDE EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE MEASURES.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018, the Borough sustained severe damages to roads, schools, public facilities, and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, local, state, and federal disaster declarations were issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25 percent) and federal (75 percent) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded \$238,787.11 for Borough-Wide emergency protective measures; and

WHEREAS, an additional invoice for an infrastructure inspection was found and submitted for consideration; and

WHEREAS, Version 1 was issued as a final cost adjustment increasing the award amount by \$390.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby amends the budget for a portion of the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake disaster, project 55027, fund 445.


