SUMMARY STATEMENT: This ordinance is sponsored by Assemblymember Yundt to name Station 6-1 the Benny Cottle Public Safety Building. The life, dedication, and service of Benny Cottle are recited in the ordinance.

While Benny Cottle provided the land that Station 6-5 sits on, that facility was named as the Roberts Public Safety Building via Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly Resolution No. 87-74. Station 6-1 is the highest staffed, most equipped, and busiest station in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough. Its naming will honor the memory of Benny Cottle, serve as a reminder of his dedication, and inspire generations to come.
