5. Substandard Road and Bridge Improvements - \$15,000,000
6. Flood and Erosion Mitigation for Susceptible Roads - \$2,000,000
7. Jonesville Public Shooting Park - \$3,000,000
8. Matanuska River Park and Campground Utility Upgrades: Phase 1 - \$2,000,000
9. Natural Gas Transmission Line to Willow - \$61,500,000
