**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-144**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 4.75, TO CHANGE THE MAKEUP OF THE FISH AND WILDLIFE COMMISSION BY DESIGNATING THE ASSEMBLYMEMBER POSITIONS AS NON-VOTING AND ADDING A NEW VOTING MEMBER.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. MSB 4.75.005, is hereby amended as follows:

4.75.005 MEMBERSHIP.

(A) The commission is composed of [NINE] seven voting members and shall consist of the following representatives:

(1) one sports fishing representative;

(2) one hunting representative; and

(3) [FOUR] five at-large representatives[;].

[(4) TWO BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATIVES; AND

(5) ONE PREVIOUS MEMBER WHO IS A NONVOTING MEMBER AND DOES NOT COUNT FOR THE PURPOSES OF A QUORUM.]

(B) The commission is also composed of three non-voting members who also do not count for purposes of a

quorum consisting of:

(1) One previous member; and

(2) Two borough assembly members.

[(B)] (C) All members of the commission shall be residents of the borough.

[(C)] (D) The commission shall select from its voting members, on a yearly basis, a chair and vice-chair.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
