SUMMARY STATEMENT: On August 31, 2023, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) Purchasing Division issued Invitation to Bid 24-006B, Construct Port MacKenzie Improvements.

The MSB and United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) funded Port Pile Sleeve Project aims to enhance the durability and longevity of the port infrastructure through a comprehensive approach. The project involves repairing identified pile splice welds to restore their structural integrity. Additionally, pile sleeves will be installed on 41-48 piles for cathodic and abrasive protection. The priority

will be given to the repair and installation of pile sleeves on 41 piles, including all deep draft dock piles and a Priority 1 pile. All work is to be completed no later than December 31, 2025.

On October 17, 2023, the MSB opened the single bid received from Western Marine Construction, Inc. The bid exceeded the available funding for the project. After consulting with the EDA, the decision was made to begin negotiation with the sole bidder in an attempt to modify the project to an acceptable scope and reduce the funding to award the project.

This action is consistent with EDA, Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) as well as MSB Code 3.08.240.

While negotiations continue, to facilitate a timely award, the Administration is requesting authorization to award a contract up to \$9,500,000 pending concurrence with EDA. An Information Memorandum will be presented to the Assembly detailing the final award amount and amended scope upon execution of the agreement.

In accordance with MSB 3.08.161, the Administration requests the authority to amend the awarded contract for an amount not to exceed \$750,000 and extend the time of performance up to 90 days for unforeseen conditions.

This project, located in Assembly District 5 will be administered the Public Works Department.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve the legislation as presented.
