A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREAT ALASKA BOWL COMPANY INC, FOR THE SUSITNA RIVER TIMBER SALE, MSB006573.

WHEREAS, timber sale MSB006573, described as the east one half of the northwest quarter, the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter, and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, approximately 800 feet east of the Parks Highway in the Trapper Creek Community Council and containing approximately 54 acres and 1,637 cords of timber is managed as Commercial Forestland within the Susitna River Natural Resource Management Unit and is included in the calculations for Annual Allowable Cut; and

WHEREAS, this timber sale is included in the current adopted Five Year Timber Harvest Schedule; and

WHEREAS, public notice for the timber sale was sent to the community council, local RSA Board, and property owners within one quarter mile of the boundary of the proposed sale and no objections were received; and

WHEREAS, the timber sale was offered by sealed competitive bid and no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, the timber sale was offered over-the-counter, and an offer was received from Great Alaska Bowl Company Inc. which meets the minimum bid price set for the competitive sale; and

WHEREAS the timber harvest operation will be in compliance with the Alaska State Forest Resources and Practices Act and applicable Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the timber industry provides jobs and an opportunity to maintain a diversified economic base in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into an agreement with Great Alaska Bowl Company Inc for the Susitna River Timber Sale, MSB006573.
