

SUMMARY STATEMENT: This legislation is coming forward at the request of Assemblymember Sumner.

In March of 2021, the Assembly approved the Fiscal Year 2022 Schedule of Rates and Fees in Resolution No. 21-016. That legislation removed the free disposal of limited amounts of residential hazardous waste disposal at the Central Landfill, but free disposal of hazardous residential waste continued at the transfer sites.

The Mat-Su Borough should be encouraging the proper disposal of residential hazardous waste materials. Improper disposal of these hazardous materials can create contamination of soil, water, and

wildlife habitats. One of the ways to encourage proper disposal of this waste is to authorize the free disposal at the Central Landfill and the transfer sites of hazardous residential waste, including used motor oil, latex paint, cooking oil, vehicle batteries, and antifreeze.

The estimated difference in revenue with this amendment is very small and will not significantly affect the overall budget of the Central Landfill.

The line items in the Fiscal Year 2022 Schedule of Rates and Fees are changed as noted by the bold underlined words in each line item below. This provides the free disposal of limited amounts of hazardous waste.
