WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-236 and Ordinance Serial No. 21-113.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for pavement rehab through the Mat-Su population corridor.

## SCOPE OF WORK

This funding will be applied to the standalone Felton Street project and the transportation bond projects listed in Proposition 1, except for the Multimodal Wasilla Depot project approved by Borough voters on November 2, 2021. \$1.5 million of this funding will be allocated to the Felton Street project with the remainder allocated to the bond projects based upon a percentage of project cost to total transportation package cost.
