RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 22-052**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY DIRECTING THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO WORK WITH THE PLANNING COMMISSION ON POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS TO THE WATERBODY SETBACK, WHICH MAY REDUCE THE SETBACK WHILE STILL PROTECTING WATER QUALITY.

WHEREAS, there is a need to look at the 75 waterbody setback for purposes of ameliorating waterbody setback violations; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to continue to protect water quality from non-point source pollution related to development adjacent to waterbodies; and

WHEREAS, this subject should be explored with MSB staff and the MSB Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby directs MSB Planning Staff to work with the MSB Planning Commission on possible amendments to the waterbody setback requirements under MSB 17.55.
