A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE HUMAN SERVICES COMMUNITY MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM AND ALLOCATING FUNDING TO NON-PROFIT SUB-GRANTEES FOR THE PROVISION OF CRITICALLY NEEDED ESSENTIAL HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the intent and rational of this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-182 and Ordinance Serial No. 22-077.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the Borough's participation in the Human Services Community Matching Grant Program.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

To provide funds for essential health services and treatment programs to non-profit organizations within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

**BUDGET**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby allocates Human Services Community Matching grant funds and authorizes the Manager to enter into grant agreements with the sub-grantees as follows:

- \$25,000.00 to Wasilla Area Seniors for the Nutrition Program;
- \$25,000.00 to United Way for the Youth 360 program;
- \$25,000.00 to Kids Kupboard for the Mobile Child Feeding program;
- \$25,000.00 to Set Free Alaska for Crisis Residential Stabilization Services;
- \$25,000.00 to The Children's Place for The Children's Place Crisis Response program;
- \$25,000.00 to Mat-Su Senior Services for Mat-Su Senior Services Assisted and Unassisted Transportation Services Program;

- \$25,000.00 to Sunshine Transit for Transit Services;
- \$15,000.00 to the Salvation Army for the Mat-Su Corps provision of food boxes;
- \$15,000.00 to Valley Charities for the Mat-Su Coalition on Housing and Homelessness;
- \$15,000.00 to Nine Star Education & Employment for the Net2Ladder: Homeless Prevention & Economic Self-Reliance program;
- \$15,000.00 to Mat-Su Food Bank for the Food Pantry of Wasilla, Food 4 Kids program;
- \$15,000.00 to Northgate Alaska for the iAMSOMEBODY program;
- \$15,000.00 to Blood-n-Fire for the Blood n Fire Food Pantry;
- \$15,000.00 to Mat-Su Health Services for the Bridgeway Support program;
- \$15,000.00 to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Mat-Su for A Formula for Impact: Standing Up to Substance Abuse, Depression, & Suicide by Developing Youth Assets; and
- \$15,000.00 to Sunshine Community Health Center for the Community Health: Behavioral Health Preventative Services program.
