SCOPE OF WORK

Restore unimpeded access for salmon to 6.5 km of stream habitat by installing a stream simulation culvert on a tributary of Birch Creek at Mastodon Road.

Restore unimpeded access for salmon to 3.11 km of stream habitat and 2.27 ha (hectares) of lake habitat by installing a steam simulation culvert on Crocker Creek at Settler's Bay Road.
