**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-107**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REAPPROPRIATING \$50,000 FROM THE CENSUS PROJECT ACCOUNT TO RECREATION SERVICES OPERATING BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE CONVERSION OF FOUR ON-CALL WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR POSITIONS INTO TWO FULL-TIME WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, Borough Pools have had trouble attracting and retaining staff; and

WHEREAS, converting four on-call staff to, two full-time positions should encourage people looking for a career as opposed to a temporary job to apply; and

WHEREAS, the addition of permanent staff will reduce training costs, employee turnover, and provide for a more robust and consistent schedule; and

WHEREAS, reappropriating \$50,000 from the Borough's Census Funding account will cover the increased cost.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Re-Appropriation Source. There is hereby reappropriated \$50,000 from the Census project no. 45002, fund 480, to fund 100, Recreational Services Fiscal Year 2023 operating budget, for two full-time water safety instructors.

Section 3. Approval of New Positions. The Assembly authorizes the conversion of four on-call water safety instructor positions into two full-time water safety instructor positions.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
