MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-088

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REPEALING MSB 17.05 ESSENTIAL SERVICE UTILITIES IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ENACTED:

WHEREAS, the rationale and intent of this ordinance are also found in IM. No. 22-171; and

WHEREAS, a goal of the 2005 Matanuska-Susitna Borough Comprehensive Development Plan is to create an attractive environment for business investment; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Energy Policy was adopted in 2014 as part of the Borough's Comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the energy policy recognizes that the Borough's economic prosperity is dependent on safe, available, reliable, and affordable residential, commercial, and industrial energy to supply the Borough's electric, heating, and transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, the energy policy seeks to coordinate governmental functions by reviewing and streamlining regulatory oversight processes; and by supporting the orderly and least-cost expansion of all utility systems in an effort to minimize the burden of increasing energy costs to residents.

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Repeal of section. MSB 17.05 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. $\underline{\text{Effective date}}$. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
