A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR ADDITIONAL PROJECT INCOME FOR THE RAIL EXTENSION PROJECT FROM PORT MACKENZIE TO THE MAINLINE.

WHEREAS, the intent and rational of this Resolution are contained in Informational Memorandum 22-239 and Ordinance Serial No. 22-132.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget as follows:

SCOPE OF WORK

The income from the properties acquired as right of way for the Rail Extension Project from Port MacKenzie to the Mainline will be used for project-related activities including right-of-way acquisition, engineering and environmental work during construction, construction of the rail embankment, security, bridges, drainage and access structures, providing project management, facilitating public information and involvement activities for the project, the purchase of heating fuel, general maintenance and/or operations items, utilities, replacement or repairs, and wages and benefits for an after-hours initial responder to emergencies occurring at the properties acquired.
