**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 24-023**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO RELOCATE A BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSE FROM AN AREA OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS IN THE BOROUGH TO A LOCATION WITHIN THE CITY OF WASILLA.

WHEREAS, MSB 8.40.060 states that the Assembly shall consider requests for the relocation of existing beverage dispensary licenses to or from an unincorporated area within the Borough to or from an incorporated city within the Borough upon notice from the Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC); and

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2023, the ABC gave notice of an application to relocate 18-1 LLC's beverage dispensary license #301 in the unincorporated area of the Borough to the Clocktower within the incorporated city of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2023, the Wasilla City Council passed Resolution #23-46 approving and waiving protest for the transfer of 18-1 LLC's beverage dispensary license #301 into the city of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Land Use Director has found the proposed action is in the public's best interest and recommended approval by the Assembly; and


WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly has considered Information Memorandum 24-042 and the Best Interest Finding and Recommendation dated February 26, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby approve the proposed relocation of 18-1 LLC's beverage dispensary license #301 to the Clocktower within the City of Wasilla.
