SCOPE OF WORK

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough, Land & Resource Management Division (Borough), requests bids from interested contractors to implement the next steps of the Alsop Interim Materials District Mine and Reclamation Plan (2023).

The Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Interim Material District (IMD) is available to the contractor and must be adhered to in development of the site (Exhibit A). The location of the site is shown on the attached Overview Map (Appendix 1 of the Mining and Reclamation Plan). The site has been in operation for many years. The Contractor shall develop and reclaim the site, as specified within the attached Plan as outlined below.

Task 1 – Survey and stake the western boundary of Cell 1 and the associated parcel boundary in preparation for Task 2.

Task 2 – Cell 1, west expansion. Fell, limb, and stack birch and spruce timber greater than seven inches diameter at breast height within the expansion area of Cell 1. Timber should be stacked within the IMD where it is out of the way and available for the public. Strip and clear the overburden about 150-feet west of the existing disturbed area, leaving no less than 100-feet of undisturbed vegetation between the IMD boundary and the parcel boundary. Overburden shall be stacked in an earthen berm in accordance with the IMD requirements.

<u>Permits</u> – The contractor shall comply with all required regulations and permits necessary for contracted activities. The pit is located on Borough-owned lands within an Interim Materials District. Work must conform to MSB 17.28 as well as the IMD application.

Bidder's Qualification Statement:

Bidder shall submit with their bid to be considered responsive the following information: 1. Bidder's experience in performing work of comparable type and size as evidenced by a list of three previously completed projects. The list should include owner contact information for each project listed.
