MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-044

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$35,000 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM, TO FUND 425, PROJECT NO. 45158, FOR CONTINUITY OF OPERATIONS AND CONTINUITY OF GOVERNMENT AND EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN WRITING SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, the Assembly accepted and appropriated funds in the amount of \$14,960 with the approval of Ordinance Serial No. 16-121, and approved the scope of work and budget with Resolution Serial No. 16-082; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received additional funding on this grant in the amount of \$35,000 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the additional grant funds in the amount of \$35,000 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant program prior to the expenditure of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for the purchase of Continuity of Operations and Continuity of Government (COOP/COG) and Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) writing software.

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 17-029; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

- Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.
- Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby accepts a grant in the amount of \$35,000 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant program, and approves an appropriation in the amount of \$35,000 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant program, to fund 425, project no. 45158, for the purchase of COOP/COG and EOP writing software.
- Section 3. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
