SUMMARY STATEMENT: In 2013, the functions of the Purchasing Division of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough were placed within the newly created Capital Projects Department. Before that time, the Purchasing Division was within the Finance department except for a transition period under the Borough Manager's Office.

The Borough Manager is constantly seeking efficiencies and good organization. At the same time, all departments and divisions must have the resources and flexibility to perform their essential work functions in the best available manner. The Borough Manager has decided that the Purchasing Division should be a direct report division to the Manager's Office so that they are closer to the throne of power.

An effort has been made to make all changes in the various parts of code to move the Purchasing Division as a direct reporting division to the Borough Manager's Office similar to Animal Control and Port MacKenzie. However, should there be an error or omission, the Clerk's office has the power to revise any
