**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-086**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 2.45, MSB 3.08, AND MSB 2.20, TO PLACE THE BOROUGH'S PURCHASING FUNCTIONS AS A DIRECT REPORTING DIVISION TO THE BOROUGH MANAGER'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the reasoning and rationale for the enactment of this ordinance are found in the Informational Memorandum accompanying this ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Repeal of subsections. MSB 2.45.020(A)(11) and (12) are repealed:

[ (11) ADMINISTRATION OF INVENTORY CONTROL OVER  
THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE BOROUGH;

(12) PURCHASING FUNCTIONS OF THE BOROUGH,]

Section 3. Amendment of subsections. MSB 2.20.030(A)(15) and (16) are hereby adopted to read as follows:

(15) administration of inventory control over the  
personal property of the borough;

**(16) purchasing functions of the borough.**

Section 4. Amendment of Section. MSB 3.08.010(A)(12) is hereby amended as follows:

(12) "Purchasing officer" means the [DIRECTOR OF CAPITAL PROJECTS] **borough employee appointed by the Borough Manager to perform the functions of the position under the title of Purchasing Officer** or designee.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect July 1, 2017.
