**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-062**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING SEPTEMBER 2012 SOUTHCENTRAL FLOOD DISASTER RELIEF MONIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,778,688 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55017.

WHEREAS, in September of 2012, due to heavy rains in the area, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained Borough-wide flood damages; and

WHEREAS, a disaster declaration was issued by the Mayor and the Manager; and

WHEREAS, the occurrence was also declared a disaster by President Obama and a large portion of the costs incurred during the disaster were determined as eligible for state and federal funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Borough has been awarded \$1,608,940 of disaster relief funds; and

WHEREAS, the design and engineering phase for repairs to the Talkeetna Dike is complete; and

WHEREAS, an amendment was issued in the amount of \$1,778,688 for the construction phase of repairs to the dike; and

WHEREAS, this work will restore the Talkeetna revetment back to pre-disaster condition; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the grant funds prior to expenditures.


BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance of and appropriates the September 2012 Southcentral Flood disaster relief monies in the amount of \$1,778,688 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
