SUMMARY STATEMENT: On March 16, 2017, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough solicited bids from qualified contractors to pump, haul and dispose of leachate from the Central Landfill Facility.

The length of the initial contract shall run from July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018. Four (4) one (1) year contract renewal options may be exercised by mutual agreement of both parties and appropriation of funds by the Assembly.
