SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT) submitted a request for the acquisition of a portion of borough-owned land. The affected parcel is legally identified as Tract A, Meadow Creek Subdivision Addition No. 1, Plat No. 2000-132, Palmer Recording District, containing 9.19 +/- acres (MSB tax parcel 5073000T00A). The DOT area of acquisition contains .72 acres more or less.

The parcel was acquired by the borough in December 2011 for purpose of constructing a public safety building to be known as Station 73. Construction of the building will commence summer of 2017. Funding for the purchase in 2011 was provided through MSB Emergency Services Department and approved by the assembly in July that same year.

The DOT acquisition of the .72 acres in Tract A is part of their on-going Parks Highway upgrade project. This phase of the project will continue the four-lane divided highway section from Church Road to Pittman Road and on through to Big Lake Road with at-grade intersections spaced every half mile from Church to Big Lake Road. Frontage roads will be improved and existing pedestrian pathways will be reconstructed and/or relocated as necessary. DOT coordinated with the borough throughout their early planning process to ensure that safe and expedient access for fire and medical emergencies was provided.

Following state and federal requirements for right-of-way acquisitions, the DOT hired MacSwain Associates, LLC, a state certified professional, to conduct the appraisal for this project. Another independent professional reviewed the appraisal report for completeness, accuracy, and compliance with industry standards. Staff also reviewed the appraisal and found it acceptable. Based on the appraisal, DOT has formally offered for acceptance by the borough an amount of \$34,800 constituting the Fair Market Value.

Pursuant to MSB 23.05.030, the manager may with the consent of the assembly, convey real property to the state of Alaska where it is in the best interest of the borough to do so. Specifically, the DOT acquired land will allow a controlled access onto the Parks Highway in both directions for emergency services and the public at large.

Public noticing has been fulfilled in accordance with MSB 23.05.025 without objection. Sale of the portion of boroughowned land to DOT has no adverse effect on development of the parcel for emergency services use and there were no objections from borough departments regarding this matter.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:
