SUMMARY STATEMENT:

On March 19, 2013 the Borough Assembly awarded Proposal No. 13-093P, to The Boutet Company for Construction Management Services for an initial 1-year term in the amount of \$1,750,000 with assembly approval required for additional periods.

On October 7, 2013, the contract amount was increased by \$273,721 to cover additional projects anticipated for future years but

initiated under the first year of contract. The new contract amount was \$2,023,721.00.

Between October 2013 and February 2015, because of change order authority, some projects were added and some projects were reduced resulting in a decrease to the contract in the amount of (\$850,340.59). The new contract amount was \$1,173,380.41.

On June 30, 2014, the contract was amended to extend the contract completion time to April 17, 2015 in order to facilitate the completion of projects underway in 2014.

On March 17, 2015, through AM 15-021 the Assembly approved a contract amendment to extend the contract until December 31, 2016, to add \$336,434.48 to the contract to provide new or additional construction management services for five additional projects. Because of clerical oversight, only \$330,792.23 was added to the contract. The new contract amount was \$1,504,172.64.

Between April 2015 and January 2016, because of change order authority, some projects were added and some projects were reduced resulting in the addition of \$106,563.77. The new contract amount was \$1,610,736.41.

On May 17, 2016 through AM 16-035, the Assembly approved an extension of the contract through June 30, 2017, an increase to the contract in the amount of \$626,508.75 to complete projects currently in progress, and two percent change order authority. The new contract amount was \$2,237,245.16.

Between June 2016 and April 2017, some projects were completed and the remaining funds in the amount of \$70,000 were removed from the contract. The new contract amount was \$2,167,245.16.

Administration is seeking Assembly approval to increase the contract in the amount of \$289,895.00 for work to be done on the Trunk Road Extension South, Phase II Construction project and for an extension of the contract through December 31, 2017. Approval of this amendment will bring the contract total to \$2,457,140.16.

In accordance with MSB 3.08.170.C.4, Administration seeks Contract Amendment authority of two percent for unknown conditions which may arise.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Recommend approval of contract amendment in the amount of TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$289,895) to THE BOUTET COMPANY's contract no. 13-093P, extend the contract to December 31, 2017, and add additional change order authority.
