SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The planning department's fiscal year 2017 budget contained funding that due to staff shortages was not fully expended. The planning department has identified projects and tasks that need to be completed and are lacking funding. Completion of these tasks and projects will not occur prior to June 30, 2017. As a result, it is necessary to reappropriate these funds into nonlapsing capital project funds.

TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR ROW ACQUISITION PROJECT \$40,370

During the subdivision process developers set aside right-of-way for roads. Depending on the size and location of the subdivision there may be a need for a future collector or arterial roan within the development. The costs for the additional right-of-way for these roads should not fall entirely on the developers. This funding will be used for acquisition of right-of-way during the subdivision process, as may be needed to ensure the design and creation of a safe and efficient transportation corridor system.

PUBLIC OUTREACH, EDUCATION & INCENTIVES \$70,000

The planning department's fiscal year 2017 budget contained funding for an air quality campaign to increase the public's awareness of the hazards associated with burning green wood. The Alaska State Department of Environmental Conservation was able to provide \$50,000 for this year's campaign; therefore the borough's money was not used. However, the air quality issue remains, and will continue to require investment as the borough labors to avoid becoming an area of nonattainment.

Public outreach regarding air quality issues, numerous re-writes of code sections resulting in changed conditions, and construction manuals which may involve new standards, all require the need for increases to public outreach. A portion of the funds in this account will be spent on these and similar outreach campaigns. The remaining funding will be used as match funding for air quality improvement grants and incentive campaigns.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY STRATEGIC PLAN SUPPORT \$15,000

The development services division is working with information technology on the implementation of the online permitting application and mobile data collection project. This funding will allow the project to move up in the queue, and allow for the use of this new system within the next year.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Staff respectfully requests Assembly adoption of the legislation reappropriating \$125,370 from the planning department fiscal year 2017 operating budget, fund 100, to fund 480; and a resolution approving the scope of work and budget for project nos. 45177, transportation corridor row acquisition project; 47052, public outreach, education and incentives; and 47050, information technology strategic plan support.
