**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-090**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$85,000 FROM THE CASWELL FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 248, TO FUND 405, PROJECT NO. 45238, TO PURCHASE A PUMPER VEHICLE AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR CASWELL FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Caswell Fire Service area is using a very outdated engine that is 38 years old; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance, safety, and reliability of this vehicle is of concern during a response; and

WHEREAS, the fire service area has the opportunity to purchase a used pumper from Anchorage Fire Department through their auction/bid process; and

WHEREAS, this is a very prudent and cost effective way to replace an aging vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Fleet Mechanic has inspected the auction vehicle and stated that it is in good running order, with only minor repairs or maintenance needed; and

WHEREAS, the Caswell Fire Service Area Fire Chief and the Caswell Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has requested an \$85,000 fund balance appropriation to project no. 45238 for the purchase, repairs, and updates of a pumper vehicle, and purchase of any related equipment; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.


Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves an appropriation in the amount of \$85,000 from the Caswell Fire Service Area fund balance, fund 248 to fund 405, project no. 45238, for the purchase, repairs, and updates of a pumper vehicle, and the purchase of any related equipment.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
