## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

In the fiscal year 2013 Capital Projects Budget, the Assembly appropriated \$30,000.00 in Enterprise Funds for Landfill Improvements, Fencing, Project No. 25046.

The Solid Waste Division has evaluated the project needs and determined that additional funding is required to complete the project and the scope of work should include upgrades and improvements to the transfer site fencing and security gates.

In the fiscal year 2016 Capital Projects Budget, the Assembly appropriated \$250,000 in Enterprise Funds for Skwentna Solid Waste Services, Landfill Closure Plan, Project No. 25030. This project is now complete leaving a balance of \$114,522.04.

The Solid Waste Division requests use of the remaining funds to allow for the Business Roadmap which will provide a financial analysis and strategic direction and for the repair, installation, and improvements of perimeter fencing and security gates at the Central Landfill and transfer sites.
