SUMMARY STATEMENT: On May 9, 2017, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough issued a solicitation seeking proposals from professional land surveying and engineering firms for right-of-way identification, survey and engineering of public road projects throughout the Borough. The intent of the work is to better manage public right-of-ways as part of the pre-design, design and construction phase of road project development.

In response to the advertisement, nine (9) proposals were received which than were evaluated by a team of six (6) Borough employees. The top 3 ranked proposers are HDL, Lounsbury and Stantec (see analysis sheet).

These contracts provide the Operations and Maintenance Division with a set of pre-qualified/pre-selected survey and design consultants, based on qualifications, for use on projects under \$75,000 from start to finish. By utilizing these agreements, consultant selection is faster and we are able to bring pricing in as a selection factor. Projects exceeding \$25,000 will be quoted between the three firms with the lowest quote being awarded the task order. It is not anticipated that annual limit will be reached on any of these contracts, however by establishing authority beyond anticipated capacity, it will allow for competition throughout the entire year.

The Public Works Department, Operation and Maintenance Division will be administering the contract with the aid of the Purchasing Division monitoring and tracking the task orders.
