SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The FY18 Capital Projects budget included projects for an animal box and some cat kennel replacements. The crematorium is in dire need of repair now, before it becomes fully inoperable. Although Animal Care still needs one more fiberglass animal box and some new cat kennels, the crematorium repair is the most urgent need.

This amendment would transfer the balance of \$25,000 from project no. 45168 to project no. 10176. Combining these two capital funds, for a total of \$61,010, will provide the shelter with enough funding to complete the estimated crematorium repairs. The scope of work for project no. 10176 will then be amended to reflect the emergency repairs of the crematorium.

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RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:

The administration supports this legislation, which will transfer the balance of funds on project no. 45168 to project no. 10176 and amend the scope of work to allow for repairs to the crematorium.
