AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$18,306 FROM TRAPPER CREEK ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 30 FUND BALANCE, FUND 284, TO FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 30050, FOR TRAPPER CREEK ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 30 CAPITAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to ensure all approved projects on the road maintenance and repair capital projects list are fully funded; and

WHEREAS, the Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to support as many future capital projects as possible; and

WHEREAS, transferring funds to the capital projects will ensure all projects on the road maintenance and repair capital projects list have adequate funding and support additional future capital projects; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 fund balance can be used to fund capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to transfer \$18,306 from Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 fund balance,

fund 284, to fund 410, project no. 30050, for the Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 Capital Projects.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves the appropriation of \$18,306 from Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 fund balance, fund 284, to fund 410, project no. 30050, Trapper Creek Road Service Area No. 30 Capital Projects.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
