**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 17-074**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENACT A SALES TAX NOT TO EXCEED 3 PERCENT OF SALES, SERVICES, AND RENTALS WITHIN SERVICE AREA NO. 36: TALKEETNA SEWER AND WATER SERVICE AREA AND SUBMITTING THE QUESTION TO THE QUALIFIED SERVICE AREA VOTERS AT THE OCTOBER 3, 2017 REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this ordinance is found in the Informational Memorandum accompanying this ordinance and the discussions of the Assembly at meetings in which it was considered.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. Section 2 of this ordinance is of a continuing and permanent nature and shall become part of Borough code. Sections 1, 3, and 4 are non-code provisions

Section 2. Adoption of section. MSB 5.25.060(D), is hereby adopted as follows:

5.25.060(E) The Borough may exercise the power to levy, collect, and enforce a sales tax not to exceed 3 percent on sales, services, and rentals within the service area.

Section 3. Submission to voters. The Borough will submit the following proposition to the qualified service area voters within

Service Area No. 36: Talkeetna Sewer and Water Service Area at the regular Borough election on October 3, 2017. The proposition must receive an affirmative vote from a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question to be approved.



Section 4. Effective date. Section 2 of this ordinance will take effect on January 1, 2018, only if the proposition in Section 3 is approved by a majority of the qualified voters who vote on the proposition at the regular Borough election on October 3, 2017. The remaining sections of this ordinance take effect immediately.
