AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$145,000 FROM GREATER WILLOW ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 20 FUND BALANCE, FUND 276, TO FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 30042, FOR GREATER WILLOW ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 20 MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to ensure that all approved projects on the road maintenance and repair capital projects list are fully funded; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to support as many future capital projects as possible; and

WHEREAS, transferring funds to the capital projects will ensure all projects on the road maintenance and repair capital projects list have adequate funding and support additional future capital projects; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 fund balance can be used to fund capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to transfer \$145,000 from Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 fund balance,

fund 276, to fund 410, project no. 30042, for the Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 capital projects.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Appropriation source</u>. The Assembly hereby approves the appropriation of \$145,000 from Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 fund balance, fund 276, to fund 410, project no. 30042, Greater Willow Road Service Area No. 20 capital projects.

Section 3. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
