## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Palmer Dispatch Center is the contracted secondary Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for the borough, and the main dispatch center for Palmer Police Department. The equipment and software currently being used for dispatch is outdated and in need of upgrades. The Palmer Dispatch Center is beginning the necessary process of upgrading their radio consoles and computer aided dispatch (CAD) system, however, these upgrades are very costly and they are seeking funding assistance from the Enhanced 911 surcharge funding.

They have submitted a request for funding and a list of equipment to the Enhanced 911 Advisory Board that falls within the acceptable expenditures under State Statute 29.35.131~911 Surcharge. On February  $13^{\rm th}$ , 2018, the Enhanced 911 Advisory

Board approved the funding amount of \$53,276 to be placed into a project account to purchase a telephone recorder, CAD mapping program and software, E-911 interface, and rapid notification capability.
