SUMMARY STATEMENT: There is an urgent need to provide safe, efficient road and pathway facilities throughout the Borough and to our schools for students, parents, staff members and community residents. State statute currently does not allow road

improvements to be included in the school bonds which construct the schools. As such this road bond package is designed to cover that additional cost. While school access is a component of the proposed bond package, the main thrust of the projects is to enhance and improve the overall transportation system within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.
