MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-080

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ELIMINATING THE SUNSET PROVISIONS FOR DISTRIBUTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAX, AND ELIMINATING THE SUNSET PROVISIONS OF THE PERMANENT MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND PERMANENT REGISTRATION OF NONCOMMERCIAL TRAILERS TO ALLOW SUCH REGISTRATIONS TO CONTINUE.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this ordinance are found in accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 18-119.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is non-code, but will have the effect of making MSB 3.24.030(B) and MSB 3.15.035(B) a general and permanent nature and a continuing portion of the Borough Code.

Section 2. <u>Deletion of Sunset Clause</u>. The sunset clause found in Section 4 of Ordinance Serial No. 14-108 as it pertains to the amendment of MSB 3.24.030(B) is deleted to read as follows:

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately [,AND SUNSET ON DECEMBER 31, 2018].

Section 3. Deletion of Sunset Clause. The sunset clause found

in Section 4 of Ordinance Serial No 14-107 as it pertains to the amendment of MSB 3.15.035(B) is deleted to read as follows:

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately [,AND SUNSET ON DECEMBER 31, 2018].

Section 4. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.

Section 5. Administrative direction. The Borough Clerk

Is directed to provide the Ordinance and Informational Memorandum
to the publisher of Code. The Borough Manager is directed to
provide notice along with the Ordinance and Informational
Memorandum to the State of Alaska and/or Department of Motor
Vehicles.
