**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 19-003**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$30,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE AND REAPPROPRIATING \$90,000 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 AREAWIDE GRANT MATCH APPROPRIATION TO FUND 440, PROJECT NO. 15051, FOR THE WASILLA CREEK HEADWATERS STREAMBANK RESTORATION.

WHEREAS, Wasilla Creek is an important waterbody within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$30,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service; and

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 2016 capital projects budget, the Assembly appropriated \$190,000 in areawide funds for grant matches; and

WHEREAS, it is our intention to use \$90,000 of this funding to fulfill the required match for this Wasilla Creek restoration grant; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must pass an ordinance to formally accept and appropriate the funds.

BE IT ENACTED:


Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Assembly does hereby accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$30,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to fund 440, project no. 15051, for the Wasilla Creek Headwaters Streambank Restoration.

Section 3. Reappropriation source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate funds from the fiscal year 2016 area-wide grant match appropriation in the amount of \$90,000 to fund 440, project no. 15051.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
