**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 19-005**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING
THE BUDGET FOR THE SEPTEMBER 2012 SOUTHCENTRAL FLOOD DISASTER
RELIEF MONIESFOR THE YODER REVETMENT PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 55017.

WHEREAS, in September of 2012, due to heavy rains in the area,
the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained Boroughwide flood damages;
and

WHEREAS, a disaster declaration was issued by the Mayor and
the Manager; and

WHEREAS, the occurrence was also declared a disaster by
President Obama and a large portion of the costs incurred during
the disaster were determined as eligible for state and federal
funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Borough has been awarded \$3,387,628 of
disaster relief funds; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly approved Resolution Serial No. 19-003,
amending the budget by \$51,920 for an alternate project, Shirley
Town Bridge; and

WHEREAS, if approved, the total budget award will be
\$3,439,548; and

WHEREAS, the Borough also received notification of award of the construction costs for the Yoder Revetment project, in the amount of \$1,450,527; and

WHEREAS, with approval of Resolution Serial No. 19-003 for Shirley Town Bridge and Resolution Serial No. 19-005, the total budget award will be \$4,890,075; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the grant funds and approve the amended budget prior to expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following amended budget for the September 2012 Southcentral Flood disaster relief monies, project no. 55017, fund 445.


