SUMMARY STATEMENT: In September 2012, due to heavy rains in the area, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained borough-wide flood damages. At the time of the disaster, a disaster declaration was issued by the Mayor and the Borough Manager. Since the occurrence was also declared a disaster by President Obama, a large portion of the costs incurred during the disaster were determined as eligible for state (Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management - DHS&EM) and federal (Federal Emergency Management
