MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 19-012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 TO FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 15050, FOR PARK IMPROVEMENTS AT THE JAY NOLFI PARK.

WHEREAS, the Jay Nolfi/Fish Creek Park in Big Lake is a treasure that is used by the community year round; and

WHEREAS, family and friends of the late Jay Nolfi are vested in making improvements to the park that is named after her; and

WHEREAS, community donations totaling \$10,000 for improvements to the park have been collected, and the community will be working with the Borough to develop a plan to include improving Americans with Disabilities Access (ADA) accessibility, repairing the pier, upgrading the creek bank, signage, fencing, and playground improvements.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Assembly hereby accepts various community donations and appropriates the amount of \$ 10,000 to fund 480, project no. 15050, for park improvements at the Jay Nolfi Park.

Section 3. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
