**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-093**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 28.60, TO CHANGE THE APPLICABILITY FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY PLAN AND TIMBER TRANSPORT PERMIT AND AMENDING MSB 28.100, DEFINITIONS.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of general and permanent nature and shall become part of borough code.

Section 2. Amendment of Subsection. MSB 28.60.070(B) is hereby replaced as follows:

[(B) IF NOT OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY THE STATE, THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO A PERSON WHO WILL BE OPERATING ON BOROUGH OR STATE ROADS FOR THEIR TIMBER HARVEST ACTIVITIES IN EXCESS OF TWO CARGO-CARRYING VEHICLES PER DAY OR TEN CARGO-CARRYING VEHICLES IN A ONE-CALENDAR-WEEK PERIOD, WHICHEVER IS MORE.]

(B) A traffic safety plan under this section is only required as part of a timber transport permit in accordance with MSB 28.60.080.

Section 3. Amendment of Section. MSB 28.100.010 is hereby amended as follows:

"Cargo-carrying vehicle" means a truck, trailer, semi-trailer, or other vehicle [CAPABLE OF CARRYING A LOAD] that is Federal Highway Administration gross vehicle weight class 7 or greater carrying harvested timber from the timber area.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
