**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 19-031**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO REPEAL
MSB 8.30, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

WHEREAS, the Borough enacted MSB 8.30, Environmental Protection, in 1980 and at that time established the South Central Clean Air Authority. The South Central Clean Air Authority does not exist and has not existed for at least the last 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the jurisdictional boundaries of the South Central Clean Air Authority include the Municipality of Anchorage and portions of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage abolished reference to the South Central Clean Air Authority in its code in 2018;

WHEREAS, many provisions of MSB 8.30, are not currently enforced or enforceable due to the non-existence of the South Central Clean Air Authority; and

WHEREAS, infractions listed in MSB 8.30, are not referenced in MSB 1.45, and have no set fine amount; and

WHEREAS, code provisions listed in MSB 8.30, are not contained in the State of Alaska court system's uniform minor offense table and they are not currently enforced by the Borough.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough code.


Section 2. Repeal of Chapter. MSB 8.30, Environmental Protection, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
