SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Great Land Trust partnered with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (Borough) on an application for a \$100,000 grant from the Mat-Su Trail and Park Foundation, which the Foundation awarded to the Borough for development of the Settlers Bay Coastal Park.

The grant funds will be used to help develop the initial infrastructure necessary to open the park to the public. Development will be in accordance with the recreation development plan, adopted by Assembly Ordinance Serial No. 18-050, August 19, 2018.

The grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$100,000. The Great Land Trust has committed to providing \$50,000 for the required cash match. The remaining match will be provided by the Land and Resources Management 2019 operating budget and the Recreation Services 2019 operating budget as in-kind donations of labor and equipment.

The Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation have indicated they will accept match provided back to the beginning of the grant period (October 2018). The resolution will amend the scope of work and budget to retroactively account for the staff time and Great Land Trust funding spent on the park since October 2018.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Staff respectfully requests the Assembly accept and appropriate \$50,000 from the Great Land Trust to the Settlers Bay Coastal Park, Project No. 15040, Fund 440 (MSB007387) and approve the amended scope of work.
