## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 19-071

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING 3.04.046 LOCAL EDUCATION FUNDING.

WHEREAS, this ordinance will revise the code pertaining to local funding for schools.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. <u>Amendment of section</u>. MSB 3.04.046 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3.04.046 LOCAL EDUCATION FUNDING.
- (A) Local education funding shall consist of two separate components: education annual operating funds and education annual debt service. The manager shall prepare the annual budget with the sum total of both components not to exceed a dollar amount equivalent of a 7.30 mill tax levy on the full and true value of the taxable real and personal property for the upcoming fiscal year projected as of February 1st.
- (B) Education Annual Operating Funds. The manager shall prepare the annual budget with education annual operating funds provided to the school district at dollar amount equivalent of a [6]7.30

mill tax levy on the full and true value of the taxable real and personal property for the upcoming fiscal year **projected** as of February 1st minus the dollar amount necessary to pay education annual debt service.

- (C) Education Annual Debt Service. Education annual debt service is the local appropriation needed to [COVER] pay the voter approved general obligation debt related to schools and educational facilities. The manager [MAY NOT REQUEST] shall present an increase in the total amount of education annual debt service [UNLESS] when:
- (2) [IT IS REQUIRED BY A] there is an actual or anticipated failure of the state of Alaska to provide match funds for education debt service; or
- (3) an increase is needed because the voters approve a bond measure for construction or repair of school buildings which requires addition to the amount needed for the borough's portion of annual debt service.
- (D) Expiration. The ordinance codified in this section shall expire July 1, 2023.

Section 3.  $\underline{\text{Effective date}}$ . This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
