A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY STATING  
NONOBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED TRAPPER CREEK VOLUNTEER FIRE  
DEPARTMENT BEING CREATED AND RECOGNIZED AS A VOLUNTEER FIRE SERVICE  
TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION IN THE TRAPPER CREEK AREA.

WHEREAS, residents of the Trapper Creek area have contacted  
the Borough regarding obtaining recognition of a volunteer fire  
department within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department  
will be a nonprofit organization, not associated with the Borough  
in any form or fashion, that will establish a fire protection plan  
for the Trapper Creek area; and

WHEREAS, residents of the Trapper Creek area have submitted  
an application to register a volunteer fire department to be known  
as the Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department, with the Alaska  
State Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire Protection;  
and


WHEREAS, in order to register with the Alaska State Department  
of Public Safety, Division of Fire Protection, the proposed Trapper  
Creek Volunteer Fire Department must obtain legislative  
nonobjection from the Borough for the volunteer fire service to  
conduct services within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, while the Borough has a recognized Trapper Creek Fire Service Area (See MSB 5.25.026), the proposed Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department will not be a Borough entity; and


WHEREAS, while the proposed Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department will not be affiliated with the Borough nor indemnified by the Borough for any acts or omissions related to fire protection or any other action, the Borough has no objection to the existence of the proposed Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department or to it providing fire protection services within the Trapper Creek area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly has no objection to the creation of the Trapper Creek Volunteer Fire Department and its registration with the Alaska State Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire Protection, as a volunteer fire service within the Borough.
